### Millésime 2018

#### JEBDUNNUCK.COM – Jeb DUNNUCK – Mai 2019

#### <u>Score</u> : 95 – 97 /100.

"Made by Marie Lefévère (of Château Sansonnet and Château Moulin du Cadet), the 2018 château Soutard-Cadet comes from a small 2.7-hectare vineyard located just in front of Château Soutard that consists of 40-year-old vines and serious limetone soils. It has a darker slant in its cassis, toasty oak, and violet-driven aromatics, which carries to a full-bodied, concentrated, powerful Saint-Emilion. That still has a beautiful elegance and purity. A blend of 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc brought up in new oak, it's another great wine from this vintage that boasts serious richness and depth yet holds onto a sense of purity, elegance, and balance."

#### THE WINE ADVOCATE – Lisa PERROTTI BROWN – Avril 2019

#### <u>Score</u> : 93 – 95 /100.

"This 2.7 hectare vineyard was acquired in 2015 by the Lefévère family, owners of the nearby Sansonnet and Moulin du Cadet. This single block, situated in front of Château Soutard, is planted to 6,000 vines per hectare and in 2018 had an average vine age of 40 years. The vineyard is planted on thin clay soils atop limestone. It will age in 100% new oak barrels for about 18 monts. The blend is 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc, and the wine has 15% alcohol. Deep-purple black colored, the 2018 Soutard-Cadet sports a fair bit of oak to begin, giving way to a core of baked blackberries, plum pudding and black Forest cake with nuances of fallen leaves and woodsmoke. Full, concentrated and densely packed with ripe, black fruits, it has a firm, grainy texture and a mineral-tinged finish. Production is expected to be just 5,000 bottles."

#### JAMESSUCKLING.COM – James SUCKLING – Avril 2019

"This is really excellent with fantastic depth and richness, yet it's always energetic and long. Medium to full-body and a juicy finish. Polished and precise. 90 per cent merlot and 10 per cent cabernet franc."

#### THE WINE CELLAR INSIDER – Jeff LEVE – Avril 2019

"This is a blend of 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc. A dark, smoky, and undeniably slick and modern style on the nose, with grilled fruits wrapped up in toasty praline and smoky oak. Quite a pretty character on the palate though, still modern and slick of course, but it does not feel overdone in terms of substance or extraction. There is a gentle flourish of plush violet cream at first, with a building backbone of peppery tannins in the middle. This is a rich but nicely grippy, well reined in, and it feels like a success, through to the long and sinewy substance in the finish."

#### VINOUS – Antonio GALLONI – Mai 2019

#### <u>Score</u> : 89 – 92 /100.

"The 2018 Soutard-Cadet is a powerhouse. Blackberry jam, chocolate, leather, licorice, violet and crushed rocks all open up in the glass. This exotically ripe, super-concentrated Saint-Émilion needs time to come together, as it is quite imposing today. The 10% Cabernet Franc adds structure and depth, but the oak needs time to come together, as the wine is not especially well balanced at this stage. Even so, there is quite a bit of potential. Tasted two times."

"Purple red colour with violet hue and black core. Expressive nose with elegant toasting aroma, lush fruit, mild spices and multi-layered character. On the palate well structured with ripe tannins, firm character, ripe fruit and convincing length."
