JEBDUNNUCK.COM – Jeb DUNNUCK – Mai 2021

Score: 94 - 96 /100.

Another incredible wine from Marie Lefévère, the 2020 Château Soutard-Cadet boasts a dense purple hue as well as awesome cassis and darker, almost blue fruits to go with lots of tobacco leaf, graphite, crushed stone, and background oak. It's another medium to full-bodied, pure, seamless wine in the vintage that stays focused and elegant on the palate, with ripe, polished tannins. The purity of fruit is terrific as well

THE WINE CELLAR INSIDER – Jeff LEVE – Juin 2020

Score: 94 - 95 / 100.

Dark in color, **the wine is round, lush, deep and rich**, with blackberry and plum liqueur notes in its core. **Sensuous, velvety** and palate coating, the wine is dense, concentrated and full-bodied, yet light on its feet.

JAMESSUCKLING.COM – James SUCKLING avril 2021

Score:94-95/100.

Blackberry with salt and white pepper. Very minerally. It's full bodied and polished with finesse and sophistication. Reminds me of the excellent 2018!

THE WINE ADVOCATE – Lisa PERROTTI BROWN – Mai 2021

Score: 93-95 /100.

Opaque purple-black colored, it charges out of the gate with powerful notes of blackberry preserves, blueberry pie and prunes, plus hints of fruitcake, Indian spices and garrigue, with a waft of licorice. The rich, concentrated, full-bodied palate is packed with **juicy black fruits** and exotic spices, supported by a rock-solid foundation of **firm**, **ripe**, **rounded tannins and tons of freshness**, **finishing long** with emerging earthy nuances.

VINOUS Antonio Galloni – Juin 2021

Score: 93-95 /100.

The 2020 Soutard-Cadet is a modern, full-throttle Saint-Émilion bursting at the seams with blackberry jam, chocolate, licorice, cloves and new leather. **Unctuous and flamboyant** in the glass, the 2020 builds effortlessly towards a crescendo of aromas and flavors that saturate the finish. I can't say this is my favorite style, but the 2020 is **impeccably done**.

DECANTER – Jane Anson – Mai 2021

Score: 90 /100.

A richer take on the vintage than some, you feel a liberal smattering of chocolate, mocha and blackberry puree being poured over the tannic frame. **There is juice here** also, and a confident swagger.

Tastingbook.com - Markus DEL MONEGO – Juin 2020

Score: 92 /100.

Dark purple color with violet hue and black core. Elegant and aromatic nose with aromas reminiscent of black cherry, boysenberries and hot chocolate. On the palate well structured with ripe and juicy fruit, mild spices and hints of chocolate, a wine with ripe tannins, **freshness and convincing length.**

The Wine Doctor – Chris Kissack– Mai 2021

Score: 91-93 /100.

It has a richly polished and lightly saturated appearance in the glass, with a crimson-black hue. The nose is **rich in ripe fruits**, with a very concentrated expression, black cherry, bilberry and black plum, all wrapped up in ribbons of charcoal, soot and toast, as well as floral notes of violets and lavender. The palate has a plush, polished and modern style, svelte, with layers of rich dark and floral fruits, touched with mint, lavender and blood orange. Underneath, **the tannins have a rich but elegant presence**, with an appropriate grip, sitting nicely within the substance of the wine. **This is quite deliciously** composed, and **should make great drinking given time. Well done**. To my surprise the alcohol is declared as 15%, but I get no heat on the palate, and it does not feel overdone.
