Château Moulin du Cadet - Millésime 2021

JEBDUNNUCK.COM - Jeb DUNNUCK - June 2022

Score : 92-94/100

Coming from a tiny 2.85-hectare vineyard purchased by the Lefèvre family in 2015, the 2021 Château Moulin du Cadet is all Merlot (the vineyard is 100% Merlot as well) that will spend 16 months in 70% new barrels. Pulled from roughly 85% of the production, it offers a deep purple hue to go with medium-bodied aromas and flavors of blackberries, cassis, crushed violets, and hints of chocolate, with subtle background oak. Nicely concentrated on the palate, with terrific balance and the vintage's elegance and purity front and center, it's going to drink nicely right out of the gate yet have 15+ years of longevity. Tasted twice.

Score : 90-92/100

The 2021 Moulin du Cadet is supple, forward and very easy to like. Bright acids and a kick of blood orange perk up a core of red/purplish berry fruit. Floral accents lend further brightness to a pretty Saint-Émilion that will drink well upon release. Tasted two times

Score : 89/91/100

"The 2021 Moulin du Cadet exhibits aromas of berries and cherries mingled with hints of raw cocoa and licorice. Medium to full-bodied, velvety and textural, with powdery tannins that assert themselves on the finish, it's a fine effort from this 2.8-hectare estate on Saint-Émilion's north slope. Soils here are molasses du Fronsadais, and Moulin du Cadet exhibits a very different grain of tannin from sister château Villemaurine."

"A fine-tannined and refined young red with blackberry, crushed stone and orange peel. Medium body. Medium finish."



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INSIDE BORDEAUX - Jane ANSON - April 2022

" Firm tannins and a touch of reduction at first, clears to show bright berry fruits, tobacco, cigar box, crushed rocks and gunsmoke minerality, with the vintage-signature tight austerity on the finish. Marie Lefèvre owner of this 2.58ha estate on the limestone plateau."

Score : 89-91/100

"The 2021 Moulin du Cadet has quite a fragrant bouquet with black cherries, iris petal and cedar aromas. The palate is medium-bodied with ripe tannins, not a powerful Saint Emilion but refined with a smooth and sensual finish. Fine."

"Dark ruby core, purple reflections, subtle brightening on the rim. Delicately savoury notes support dark cherry fruit, liquorice and cherries with a hint of nougat and orange zest. Fresh, red berry fruit concentrate palate with a lively acidity and a chalky lemon finish."

Score : 93/100

"Dark purple colour with violet hue and black core. Opulent nose with concentrated character, pure fruit and fine toasting, dark berries, blackberries and elderberries, hints of fresh ground coffee and mild spices. On the palate freshness and elegance yet with a certain persistence, very good length and mouth-watering finish."
