




Château Sansonnet- Millésime 2023

JAMESSUCKLING.COM - James SUCKLING - Avril 2024

Score : 93-94/100

“A juicy and fruity red with blackberry and currant aromas and crunchy flavors on a medium body. Refined for the vintage.”

JEB DUNNUCK - Mai 2024

“Cassis, darker blackberries, spicy wood, and an undeniable sense of minerality all emerge from the 2023 Château Sansonnet, a medium to full-bodied 2023 that has terrific purity and elegance, as well as ample fruit and texture. It shines on all accounts and is unquestionably another beautiful wine from this team that has tons to love. The 2023 is 87% Merlot, 8% Cabernet Franc, and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon from a single parcel on the upper, limestone plateau that will spend 16 months in 70% new barrels, 22% in foudre, and 8% in amphora.”

« The 2023 Sansonnet is very composed on the nose with detailed, nicely focused black cherry and blueberry fruit, the oak subsumed. The palate is medium-bodied with pliant tannins and commendable weight and density, though it does not impose heavily. Fresh, with touches of blood orange on the grippy finish, this is a Saint Emilion that I might tuck away for several years. Promising. »

« A rich, potent wine, the 2023 Sansonnet is packed with blackberry, spice, leather, licorice, menthol and chocolate. Readers will find an ample, sumptuous Saint Emilion built on textural resonance and pure power, buffered by the high acids that are so typical of this site. Tasted three times. »

THE WINE CELLAR INSIDER- Jeff Leve - Mai 2024

Score : 94-96/100

« I like the freshness here, which is exacerbated by its notes of citrus, red fruits, flowers, licorice, smoke, and cocoa. On the palate, the wine is equally complex with its opulent, lush, polished, silky-textures, and crush-rock accents. There is length, and purity here. The change in the in barrel ageing program has allowed for more freshness, elegance, and purity to express itself in the wine. The wine blends 87% Merlot, 8% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon. 14.5% ABV. Harvesting took place September 20-October 3. Drink from 2028-2045. »

Yves Beck- Avril 2024

Score : 95-96/100

“Invitantes nuances florales, épicées et fruitées dans le bouquet de Sansonnet ! Précis et linéaire, le vin surprend par son tempérament, par son côté déterminé. Lui qui a si souvent adopté des profils plus opulents, plus amples, souhaite visiblement démontrer qu’il est tout à fait en mesure de se profiler par de la fraîcheur tout en gardant son caractère velouté et ses tannins suaves. Un vin de toute beauté avec une touche de piment ! Bravo. 2029-2048 “

Jean Marc Quarin - Avril 2024

Score : 95/100

Couleur noire. Nez intense, fruité, sentant bon la mûre et la cerise. Evolue complexe à l'agitation du verre. Tout en douceur tactile, avec un corps fondant et des saveurs profondes évoquant les fruits noirs. Finale séveuse et minutieusement tramée. C'est le luxe et la volupté. Un coup de coeur pour la seconde année consécutive. Bravo ! Assemblage : 87 % merlot, 8 % cabernet franc, 5 % cabernet sauvignon. Degré d'alcool : 14°5 - pH : 3,45. Rendement : 30 hl/ha. Production : 26 000 bouteilles.

Marcus Del Monego - Mai 2024

Score : 93+/100

“Dark purple colour with violet hue and black core. Very concentrated nose with distinct fruit, plums, boysenberries and mulberries, floral hints and mild spices in the background, fine toasting. On the palate well structured with good aromatic length and a certain depth, hints of oriental spices in the finish.”

FALSTAFF – Peter Moser– Mai 2024

Score : 93/100

“Deep dark ruby, opaque core, purple reflections, brightening at the edge. Dark nougat, cranberries, black cherries, blackberry confit, tobacco and wood nuances in the underlay. A juicy palate, red berryish, fresh structure, integrated with supporting tannins; a modern style showing some length and good ageing potential. “

Terre de Vins– Mai 2024

Score : 92-93/100

« La finesse et la concentration ne sont pas incompatibles et ce vin le prouve par son aspect fardé, poudré et ses notes de fleurs légères. Le grain est fin au milieu d'une matière riche et ample. La finale reste empreinte d'une belle fraîcheur avec sa pointe d'agrumes désaltérants. »

THE WINE DOCTOR - Chris Kissack - Avril 2024

Score : 92-94/100

“This is a blend of 87% Merlot, 8% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon. An intense nose suggesting some concentration, with dark berry fruits richly dressed with layers of dark chocolate, coffee bean, leather and toast. The palate is gently polished, lightly velvety, with a rich core of very dark fruits, all currant, dark chocolate, coffee bean and tar, which comes with a rich seam of grippy tannins, adding a firm frame to the structure of the wine. Dense, richly built, even while it still carries the sinewy and bright DNA of the vintage, the tannins are firm and well knit, and they seem to suit the palate. Long and wrapped in a grip of ripe tannins and scented oak at the end. It will take some time to come around, this one, but it certainly has potential. Tasted three times.”

VINUM - Adrian van Velsen - Avril 2024

Score : 91-93/100

“La barrique domine au nez, notes fumées, réglisse, tabac noir, fruit mûr ; construit de manière intense, avec des tanins à grain fin et un fruit délicat, le bois est bien enrobée, les tanins ne se font sentir qu'en fin de bouche. Long, frais, avec des myrtilles en arrière-goût. Il plaît beaucoup plus que l'année dernière grâce à sa fraîcheur.”

Coup de cœur Must-have 93 Tannin voluptueux et galbé, avec de la souplesse et de la pulpe. Structure précise, longue finale : le cru devrait parfaitement évoluer au cours de son élevage
